GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Only participants recognized by the respective schools will be the authentic participants.
- One student is permitted to participate in one event only.
- **One event, one participant** policy applies for all the competitions. E.g. the student who has participated in Essay competition **cannot** participate in the elocution competition etc. But the literary competitors can participate in the cultural extravaganza.
- Every school must compulsorily send a mentor (teacher) along with their students
- Participants must carry the school identity; the event identity cards will be issued at the time of registration. Event ID is **a must** during the event.
- The participant should be gentle and friendly to the other competitors, judges, organizers and guests.
- In case of any problem, the participants must bring the issue to their in-charge mentor, who will then approach the event organizer on their behalf to solve the issue.
- The mentor and the school shall be held responsible for any damage done to a person or property by his / her students
- The decision of the judging panel will be final and binding on all contestants.
- **Wherever the rules are silent the organizer's decision will be final.**
- In no way shall the organizers be held responsible for loss of any electronic gadgets, ornaments, equipment etc.
- Fest venue gates will open at 8:00 am and close at 7:00 pm. Therefore, no student shall be allowed inside the college premises before 8:00 am and shall not stay back after 7:00 pm.
- Participants should carry their own lunch and water bottle; food kiosks shall also be put up.
- No plastic will be allowed inside the college premises.
- Discipline and cleanliness have to be strictly maintained throughout the 4 days of the fest.

- Negative marking if the participants exceed time limit
- Marks for discipline and cleanliness of the allotted classes will also count for the grand total of winning the **General Championship**.
- For winning the **General Championship**, the school must participate in all the **cultural** events. The general championship will be awarded to the **cultural fest winners**.
- Literary events like essay, elocution and quiz competition have their own cash prizes and trophies.
- The last date for Registration is 21st November 2022.

FR. JACOB MEMORIAL INTER-SCHOOL FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT 7 A Side Knockout-Cum-League for Boys & Girls

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The tournament will be held from **23rd Nov to 26th Nov 2022**.
2. It is a **7+3 a side knock-out + league** format inter school football tournament.
3. Venue for the tournament is St Paul's PU College Ground, Camp, Belgavi
4. All teams must fill in the team registration form along with School seal and Principal signature.
5. **All teams will play first round in knockout format round. 4 qualified teams will play Super league format.**
6. All teams must submit the filled in form before **18th Nov 2022 along with entry fees of Rs 800**.
7. Max 3 teams can register from one school.
8. All teams must have same coloured team kit. Shin guards are compulsory
9. **Student ID Cards & Fee Receipt for Current year are compulsory.**
10. Rolling Substitutions are allowed for every game.
11. In knockout format, If any match ends in draw, winner will be decided on a **"Penalty shootout"**.
12. All teams must report 20mins before the scheduled time. If a team fails to report for the game then a victory shall be awarded to opposite team.
13. No rematch If the match is stopped due to rain/bad light or any other reason.
14. **Referee's decisions** will be final throughout the tournament. Any sort of misconducts by any player/team will result in direct suspension. Any Protest shall be made in writing along with protest fee of Rs 500 to the organising committee within 30mins of termination of the match.
15. Any Misconduct by player/team will result in team disqualification.
16. Organizing Committee reserves all rights.
17. The tournament will be under CCTV Surveillance.
18. Any fights/Quarrels will be directly handled by the police.
19. Any Injuries & Casualties during matches, the committee will not be held responsible.
